ORDER

The Chief Engineer , Harbour Engineering Department has reported that the Ministry of Agriculture, Government of India has empanelled the Harbour Engineering Department as a technical consultant for undertaking consultancy services in other maritime states. The Chief Engineer has therefore requested that permission may be granted for taking up the work of consultancy service in other maritime states.

Government have examined the proposal and are pleased to declare the Harbour Engineering Department as a consultant in the field of development of Fishing Harbour and fish landing centres, and to accord sanction to take up consultancy service in other maritime states. Subject to the following conditions:-

- i) No additional posts will be created and the existing technical staff will carry out the work, in addition to their normal duty without adversely affecting such normal work;
- ii) the employees will not be paid a share of the consultancy fees , which will entirely flow to the Government exchequer.
